RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS


The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region, finds that:

1. The below-listed Board Orders contain waste discharge requirements for waste discharge facilities that are no longer discharging wastes, or are discharging wastes that are now considered to have a minimal effect on water quality, or were never constructed.
2. It is desirable to rescind said below-listed Board Orders.
3. The Board forwarded timely notices by mail to persons responsible for each of the below-listed Orders who submitted the original reports of waste discharge, explaining the Board's considerations of rescinding the particular Order, and requesting timely comments.
4. The Board at a public hearing heard and considered all comments pertaining to the proposed rescinding of the below-listed Orders.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, the following Orders containing waste discharge requirements are rescinded:
