**RESCISSION OF CEASE AND DESIST ORDER NO. 75-4
AND ADDENDUM NO. 1 AGAINST
THE CITY OF CALIPATRIA;
CEASE AND DESIST ORDER NO. 81-47 AGAINST
JOE MAGGIO, INC;
AND CEASE AND DESIST ORDER NO. 75-7
AND ADDENDUM NO. 1 AGAINST
HEBER PUBLIC UTILITIES DISTRICT**

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region, finds that:

1. The City of Calipatria has ceased discharging to surface waters of the State of California, and is no longer subject to effluent limitations contained in Board Order No. 74-131 (NPDES No. CA0104369), thereby resolving the water quality control problems which necessitated the adoption of Cease and Desist Order No. 75-4 and Addendum No. 1, thereto.
2. Joe Maggio, Inc. has constructed additional wastewater treatment and disposal facilities and is no longer discharging to the Alamo River in violation of Board Order No. 74-84, thereby resolving the water quality control problems which necessitated the adoption of Cease and Desist Order No. 81-47.
3. Heber Public Utilities District has constructed additional wastewater treatment and disposal facilities. Wastewater discharged is no longer in excess of effluent limitations prescribed by waste discharge requirements, thereby resolving the water quality control problems necessitating the adoption of Cease and Desist Order No. 75-7 and Addendum No. 1, thereto.
4. Enforcement actions as specified in Cease and Desist Orders No. 75-4 and Addendum No. 1, thereto, 81-47, and 75-7 and Addendum No. 1, thereto, are no longer required.
5. The Board forwarded timely notices by mail to the dischargers and to all other affected persons and agencies, explaining its intent to rescind Cease and Desist Orders No. 75-4 and Addendum No. 1, thereto, 81-47, and 75-7 and Addendum No. 1, thereto.
6. The Board in a public meeting heard and considered all comments pertaining to the rescission of Cease and Desist Orders No. 75-4 and Addendum No. 1, thereto, 81-47, and 75-7 and Addendum No. 1, thereto.


