RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region, finds that:


1. The below listed Board Orders contain waste discharge requirements for waste discharge facilities that were never constructed, or have discharges that are less than 15,000 gallons-per-day and are now considered insignificant, or are no longer in use.
2. It is desirable to rescind said below-listed Board Orders.
3. The Board forwarded timely notices by mail to persons responsible for each of the below-listed Orders, explaining the Board's considerations of rescinding the particular Order, and requesting timely comments.
4. The Board at a public hearing heard and considered all comments pertaining to the proposed rescission of the below-listed Orders.
