**RESCISSION OF
WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS**

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Colorado River Basin Region, finds that:

1. For the reasons stated below, it is desirable to rescind said below-listed Board Order(s).
2. The Board timely forwarded notices by mail to persons responsible for the below-listed Board Order(s) explaining the Board's consideration of rescinding the particular Board Order(s), and requesting comments.

Reason for rescission: The facility ceased using recycled wastewater from CVWD's Water Reclamation Plant No. 9 (WRP9) in Palm Desert in January 2015. This was followed by demolition and permanent decommissioning of WRP9 in early 2016. The facility is currently enrolled in the Colorado River Basin Water Board's General Order 97-700 for Discharge of Recycled Water for Golf Course and Landscape Irrigation, using recycled water from other sources.
