33°44'20"W. The proposed project site is located at 43570 Phyllis Jackson Way, Palm Desert,
Riverside County, California. The project site may also be identified by the Assessor's Parcel
Numbers 624-160-009 and 624-230-015.

Project Description:

Desert Sands Unified School District is proposing a nearly complete reconstruction of Palm
Desert High School. The project would be completed in two main phases. The first phase
was completed in August 2011. Phase 2 is expected to begin in June 2011 with the
demolition of all buildings within the southern portion of the site. Phase 2 Construction
includes four new ball fields and four new hard courts. Phase 2 would take approximately
sixteen months to complete and is expected to be ready for use in September 2012. The 401
certification application was submitted because a concrete armor will be constructed atop of
the existing earthen manufactured bank of the Whitewater River channel to protect the
channel from stormwater erosion.
