1 ²	<p>Permittee gives away all manure; or</p> <p>Third party composts³ manure on-site and compost is transferred off-site; or</p> <p>Third party composts ³ manure on-site and compost is spread on land owned/operated by the CAFO; or</p> <p>Raw manure is transferred off site, composted, and finished compost is returned to the CAFO for land application.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Engineered Waste Management Plan • Storm Water Management Structure Inspections Log • Water Line Inspections Log • Manure Nutrient Analyses ⁴ • Manure Tracking Manifest
2 ^{2, 5}	<p>Permittee composts their manure on-site and then applies to their land; or</p> <p>Permittee composts manure on site and transfers compost to third party (off-site).</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Case 1 Requirements, plus • Inventory of Composting Operations
3 ²	<p>Permittee spreads manure (raw) on land under their control.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Case 1 Requirements, plus • Nutrient Management Plan

² Permittee are required to submit to the Imperial County Air Pollution Control District, Rule 307 annual permit fee.

³ Third Party Composter to submit Report of Waste Discharge (ROWD) Application to Regional Board.

⁴ Manure Nutrient Analyses only required of Large CAFOs – 700 or more mature dairy cows (dry or milking) or 1,000 or more head of cattle

⁵ Permittee/Composter required to obtain Composting Permit from Imperial County Public Health Department, a permit is required from the Local Enforcement Agency for the California Integrated Waste Management Board if more than 1,000 cubic yards of compost product is either sold or given away annually (14 CCR 17856).
