**SECTION I: Introduction**

The Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA) Amendments of 1996 included provisions requiring the States to complete an annual report on violations of national primary drinking water regulations by the public water systems in their state. This annual report must identify violations of primary drinking water standard maximum contaminant levels (MCL), treatment requirements, variances and exemptions, and significant monitoring requirements.

Public water systems served approximately 34.1 million people in California during the 2003 calendar year. Approximately 1.8 million people in California received their drinking water from other sources, primarily private wells serving individual residences.

The California Department of Health Services (Department) is designated by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) as the primacy agency responsible for the administration and enforcement of the federal SDWA requirements in California. The State of California and the Department have adopted statutes and regulations to implement the requirements of the SDWA. The Department's regulatory responsibility over public water systems includes (1) issuance of operating permits, (2) conducting inspections, (3) monitoring for compliance with regulations, and (4) taking enforcement action to compel compliance when violations are identified.

The Department has delegated the drinking water program regulatory authority for small public water systems serving less than 200 service connections to thirty-five (35) counties in California. The delegated counties (or Local Primacy Agencies) are responsible for regulating approximately 4,000 small public water systems statewide. The Department retains the regulatory authority over all public water systems statewide with greater than 200 service connections and the small public water systems in the remaining twenty-three (23) non-delegated counties. A list of the delegated counties is included in Appendix C of this report.

The Department submits drinking water regulatory program data electronically to the USEPA for compilation in the federal Safe Drinking Water Information System (SDWIS) on a quarterly basis. The data submitted to SDWIS typically includes (1) public water systems inventory statistics, (2) MCL violations, Major Monitoring and Treatment Technique violations, (3) the enforcement actions taken by the Department against public water systems for violations, and (4) variances and exemptions. The USEPA regions also report federal enforcement actions into the SDWIS database.

During the calendar year 2003, the Department experienced technical problems in the electronic transmittal of water quality and violations data into the federal SDWIS. As a result, the information available from the federal SDWIS is considered incomplete and does not accurately reflect the status of drinking water compliance in the State of California. The Department is aggressively working with the USEPA to resolve the data transfer issues and problems to ensure the completeness and accuracy of the SDWIS data in the future. Consequently, the violations information included in this report is derived from the data available from the Department's independent drinking water program database system for the period of January 1, 2003 through December 31, 2003.

## **SECTION II: Primary Drinking Water Standards / Water Quality Monitoring**

Primary drinking water standards have been adopted by the Department for contaminants that may be found in drinking water supplies in California. The standards are set at levels necessary to protect the public from acute and chronic health risks associated with consuming the contaminants in the drinking water supplies.

Public water systems are required to serve drinking water that meets all of the Department's drinking water standards, and to conduct routine sampling and analysis of their drinking water supplies to certify compliance. Further, all water quality analysis must be conducted by laboratories that are certified by the Department and the analytical results transmitted electronically to the Department. The water quality analytical results are reviewed and evaluated by the Department to determine compliance with drinking water standards. The Department identifies and reports violations when public water systems submit water quality analytical results that exceed the established drinking water standards.

Public water systems are required to notify the Department within forty-eight (48) hours of receiving water quality analytical results indicating a failure to meet any primary drinking water standard. In the case of a bacteriological or nitrate/nitrite drinking water standard violation, public water systems are required to notify the Department within twenty-four (24) hours of receiving water quality analytical results indicating an MCL has been exceeded.

A monitoring violation is reported when a public water system fails to conduct the required water quality sampling and analysis or to report the analytical results to the Department or the appropriate Local Primacy Agency.

## **SECTION III: Variances And Exemptions**

The Department is authorized under the federal SDWA to issue variances and exemptions from meeting drinking water standards to public water systems under special circumstances.

A variance is allowed in situations where the characteristics of a raw water source make it impossible for a public water system to meet the MCL with the installation of the best available technology, treatment techniques, or other approved method. The approval of any variance must ensure adequate protection of human health. Additionally, the variance is reviewed by the Department not less than every five (5) years to determine whether continuation of the variance is appropriate and necessary.

An exemption from an MCL and/or treatment technique is allowed in situations where a public water system is in noncompliance as the result of compelling factors and the exemption will not result in an unreasonable risk to public health. Any public water systems that receive an exemption must achieve compliance with the MCL or treatment technique as expeditiously as practicable, but not later than three (3) years after the applicable compliance date.

During calendar year 2003, the Department did not approve any variances. However, under conditions specified by the Department, a church in Monterey County received a single exemption from the drinking water standards for hand washing in a restroom.

#### **SECTION IV: Summary of Violations**

This section identifies the categories of primary drinking water standards and summarizes the public water system violations data for calendar year 2003 included in Appendix A. The identities of the public water systems in violation are included in Appendix B.

##### Organic Contaminants

Public water systems were required to meet primary drinking water standards for sixty-two (62) organic contaminants. Eight (8) MCL violations and sixty (60) monitoring violations were incurred by ten (10) public water systems.

##### Inorganic Contaminants

Public water systems were required to meet primary drinking water standards for seventeen (17) inorganic contaminants. 159 MCL violations and 119 monitoring violations were incurred by 170 public water systems.

##### Radionuclide Contaminants

Public water systems were required to meet primary drinking water standards for six (6) radionuclide contaminants. A total of two (2) MCL violations were incurred by two (2) public water systems.

##### Total Trihalomethanes

Public water systems were required to meet primary drinking water standards for total trihalomethanes contaminants. A total of three (3) MCL violations were incurred by two (2)

public water systems and a total of two (2) monitoring violations were incurred by two (2) other public water systems.

### Total Coliform Rule

The Total Coliform Rule violations identify the presence of microbiological contamination in drinking water supplies or failure of a PWS to conduct the required water quality monitoring for coliform bacteria, which is the basis for establishing compliance with the drinking water bacteriological standard.

A total of seventy-one (71) acute violations were incurred by sixty-four (64) public water systems and 661 non-acute violations were incurred by 494 public water systems.

An acute violation indicates that a public water system detected fecal coliform or E. coli bacteria in their drinking water supply. A non-acute (monthly) violation indicates that a public water system detected total coliform bacteria in five percent (5%) of the water samples analyzed in a month in their drinking water supply.

There were also 1,107 significant monitoring and/or reporting violations incurred by 740 public water systems. These violations were issued for failure to conduct the required bacteriological monitoring for coliform bacteria or required follow-up monitoring of their water systems or failure to contact the Department.

### Surface Water Treatment Rule

The Surface Water Treatment Rule establishes treatment techniques and performance standards for public water systems that use surface water as a drinking water source. These treatment techniques and performance standards are used to establish water quality objectives instead of MCL's for microbiological contaminants that may be found in surface waters including Giardia lamblia, Cryptosporidium parvum, Legionella, heterotrophic plate count, and viruses.

Public water systems that use surface water are required to provide multi-barrier treatment to protect against adverse health effects from microbiological contaminants. All multi-barrier treatment systems must include the use of a filtration technology approved by the Department. Public water systems may be approved by the Department to use surface water without providing filtration under certain conditions and requirements. A water system that fails to meet these conditions and requirements is reported as a "failure to filter" violation.

For public water systems with approved filtration treatment systems, forty-one (41) public water systems incurred a total of eighty-seven (87) treatment technique violations, and twelve (12) public water systems incurred twenty (20) significant monitoring violations.

For public water systems with approval to use surface water without filtration, four (4) public water systems incurred a total of ten (10) significant monitoring violations.

A monitoring violation is considered significant under the Surface Water Treatment Rule when fewer than ten percent (10%) of the required water samples are taken or the water quality monitoring results are not reported during the required reporting interval.

## **SECTION V: Conclusions**

Overall, public water systems in California delivered drinking water that generally met all of the established state and federal drinking water standards and was safe to drink. A detailed breakdown of the violations and their health effect significance for each contaminant category is provided below.

### Organic Contaminants

Violations of drinking water standards for organic contaminants by public water systems affected approximately 9,789 people in California (99.97% total compliance). Additionally, four (4) public water systems that serve drinking water to approximately 391 people failed to conduct all of the required water quality monitoring and reporting for organic contaminants. The specific violations are as follows:

Two (2) public water systems serving a total of approximately 295 people, each incurred a single monitoring violation for each of the following twenty-nine (29) organic contaminants: endrin, toxaphene, glyphosate, simazine, di (2-ethylhexyl) phthalate, carbofuran, atrazine, heptachlor, heptachlor epoxide, 2,4-D, 2,4,5-TP (silvex), cis-1,2-dichloroethylene, dibromochloropropane, ethylene dibromide, total xylenes, 1,2-dichlorobenzene, vinyl chloride, 1,1-dichloroethylene, 1,1-dichloroethane, trans-1,2-dichloroethylene, 1,2-dichloroethane, 1,1,1-trichloroethane, carbon tetrachloride, 1,2-dichloropropane, tetrachloroethylene, 1,1,2,2-tetrachloroethane, monochlorobenzene, benzene, and ethylbenzene. The failure to complete the required contaminant monitoring prevented these public water systems from demonstrating compliance with the adopted drinking water standards.

Dibromochloropropane MCL violations (greater than 0.0002 mg/l) were incurred by five (5) public water systems that serve approximately 9,724 people and monitoring violations were incurred by four (4) public water systems that serve approximately 391 people. The consumption of drinking water with levels of dibromochloropropane exceeding the MCL over a long timeframe could increase the risk of cancer in humans and the failure to complete the required contaminant monitoring prevented these public water systems from demonstrating compliance with the adopted drinking water standards.

A single cis-1,2-dichloroethylene MCL violation (greater than 0.006 mg/l) was incurred by a single public water system that serves approximately sixty-five (65) people. The consumption of drinking water with levels of cis-1,2-dichloroethylene exceeding the MCL over a long timeframe could increase the risk of damage to the liver, nervous system, and circulatory system in humans.

A single tetrachloroethylene MCL violation (greater than 0.005 mg/l) was incurred by a single public water system that serves approximately sixty-five (65) people. The consumption of

drinking water with levels of tetrachloroethylene exceeding the MCL over a long timeframe could increase the risk of cancer in humans.

### Inorganic Contaminants

Violations of drinking water standards for inorganic contaminants by public water systems affected approximately 25,444 people in California (99.92% total compliance). Additionally, 100 public water systems that serve approximately 23,256 people failed to conduct all of the required water quality monitoring and reporting for inorganic contaminants. The specific violations are as follows:

A single aluminum MCL violation (greater than 1 mg/l) was incurred by a single public water system that serves approximately sixty-six (66) people. Consuming drinking water with levels of aluminum exceeding the MCL over a long timeframe, could increase the risk of short-term gastrointestinal effects in humans.

Arsenic MCL violations (greater than 0.05 mg/l) were incurred by four (4) public water systems that serve approximately 387 people and monitoring violations were incurred by two (2) public water systems that serve approximately 303 people. Consuming drinking water with levels of arsenic exceeding the MCL over a long timeframe, could increase the risk of cancer or damage to the skin or circulatory system in humans.

Cadmium MCL violations (greater than 0.005 mg/l) were incurred by two (2) public water system that serve approximately 337 people. Consuming drinking water with levels of cadmium exceeding the MCL over a long timeframe, could increase the risk of damage to the kidney in humans.

Mercury MCL violations (greater than 0.002 mg/l) were incurred by two (2) public water systems that serve approximately 106 people. Consuming drinking water with levels of mercury exceeding the MCL over a long timeframe, could increase the risk of mental disturbances or impaired physical coordination, speech, and hearing, in humans.

Fluoride MCL violations (greater than 2 mg/l) were incurred by one (1) public water system that serves approximately fifty-two (52) people and a single monitoring violation was incurred by one (1) public water system that serves approximately fifty-two (52) people. Consuming drinking water with levels of fluoride exceeding 4 mg/l over many years may increase the risk of bone disease, including pain and tenderness of the bones. Children who consume drinking water with levels of fluoride exceeding 2 mg/l may increase the risk of mottled teeth.

Nitrate (NO<sub>3</sub>) MCL violations (greater than 45 mg/l) were incurred by seventy-nine (79) public water systems that serve approximately 24,496 people and nitrate monitoring violations were incurred by ninety-seven (97) public water systems that serve approximately 22,901 people. Consuming drinking water with levels of nitrate exceeding the MCL can cause serious illness and possible death in infants that are less than six (6) months of age.

### Radionuclides

Violations of drinking water standards for radionuclide contaminants by public water systems affected approximately 220 people in California (99.99% total compliance).

Uranium MCL violations (greater than 20 pCi/l) were incurred by two (2) public water systems that serve approximately 220 people. Consuming drinking water with levels of uranium exceeding the MCL over a long timeframe, could increase the risk of damage to the kidney or the risk of cancer in humans.

### Total Trihalomethanes

Violations of drinking water standards for total trihalomethane contaminants by public water systems affected approximately 37,250 people in California (99.89% total compliance). The specific violations are as follows:

Total trihalomethanes MCL violations (greater than 0.1 mg/l) were incurred by two (2) public water systems that serve approximately 37,250 people and total trihalomethane monitoring violations were incurred by two (2) water systems that serve approximately 36,045 people. Consuming drinking water with levels of total trihalomethanes exceeding the MCL over a long timeframe, could increase the risk of liver, kidney, or central nervous system problems or increase the risk of cancer in humans.

### Total Coliform Rule

Violations of bacteriological drinking water standards by public water systems affected approximately 584,696 people in California (98.28% total compliance). The specific violations are as follows:

Acute bacteriological violations were incurred by sixty-four (64) public water systems that serve approximately 8,920 people. Fifty-nine (59) public water systems incurred a single acute bacteriological MCL violation, which indicates that the circumstances causing the bacteriological contamination of their drinking water supplies were corrected immediately.

Five (5) public water systems each incurred two (2) single consecutive acute bacteriological violations. These violations indicate that the affected population was

briefly exposed to a significant public health risk due to bacteriological contamination of their drinking water supplies.

Non-acute (monthly) bacteriological violations were incurred by 494 public water systems that serve approximately 576,001 people. Typically, these non-acute (monthly) bacteriological violations are the result of improper water sampling and/or inadequate cleaning of water distribution system pipelines.

375 public water systems each incurred a single non-acute (monthly) violation and 119 public water systems incurred anywhere from two (2) to five (5) non-acute (monthly) violations.

Bacteriological monitoring violations were incurred by 765 public water systems that serve approximately 157,744 people. The failure to complete the required bacteriological monitoring prevented these public water systems from demonstrating compliance with the primary drinking water standards for bacteriological quality.

### Surface Water Treatment Rule

Approximately 99.47% of California's population served by public water systems that use surface water received drinking water that continuously satisfied the filtration treatment and monitoring provisions of the Surface Water Treatment Rule. The specific violations are as follows:

For public water systems with approved filtration treatment, treatment technique violations were incurred by forty-one (41) public water systems that serve approximately 178,441 people. Sixteen (16) of these forty-one (41) public water systems incurred the violation for only one (1) month, fifteen (15) public water systems incurred the violation for two (2) months, six (6) public water systems incurred the violation for three (3) months, one (1) public water system incurred the violation for four (4) months, two (2) public water system incurred the violation for six (6) months, and one (1) public water system incurred the violation for seven (7) months. Significant monitoring violations were incurred by twelve (12) public water systems that serve approximately 1,013 people.

For public water systems with approval to use surface water without filtration, significant monitoring violations were incurred by four (4) public water systems that serve approximately 453 people.

The Surface Water Treatment Rule treatment technique violations are typically incurred due to elevated turbidity levels in the water or a failure to maintain the required level of disinfection. High turbidity levels or inadequate disinfection are indicators of potential breakthrough of cryptosporidium, giardia, bacteria, or viruses in the treatment process which could create a public health risk.

### Enforcement Activities

In response to the violations identified in this report, the Department issued a total of 918 enforcement letters, 320 citations, and 21 compliance orders to the affected public water systems. This aggressive enforcement action is a key element of the Department's overall regulatory strategy to bring all public water systems into full compliance with all of the drinking water standards and regulations and ensure that all Californians receive safe drinking water.

The Department's enforcement actions against a public water system that violates a primary drinking water standard will vary according to the type of contaminant and the specific health risk from exposure to the contaminant in the drinking water.

Typically, the Department will require a public water system to immediately perform one or more of the following items depending upon the severity of the public health risk.

- Cease operation of the water system and provide an alternate source of safe drinking water.
- Shutdown or abandon the contaminated drinking water source.
- Conduct additional water quality monitoring to identify the cause and extent of the contamination and take appropriate corrective action.
- Modify the water treatment processes to eliminate the contamination.
- Provide notification of the drinking water contamination to water consumers and identify the potential health risks.
- Issue a “Boil Water Notice” (for bacteriological contamination) or “Do Not Drink Notice” (for contamination by other regulated contaminants).

For treatment technique and monitoring violations, the Department will require the public water system to conduct the required contaminant monitoring program and/ or provide the appropriate water treatment.

Additional enforcement actions available to the Department include revoking or suspending a public water system’s operating permit, assessing civil penalties up to \$25,000 per day for each day a drinking water standard violation occurs, or placing a public water system into receivership.
