The Division of Drinking Water and Environmental Management of the Department of Public Health (hereinafter Department) hereby issues a citation to the Glenview Mobile Park (mailing address: 3438 Siesta Way, Oxnard, CA 93033) for the following violation:

1. Section 116650 of Chapter 4, Part 12, Division 104 of the California Health and Safety Code (H&S Code), authorizes the issuance of a citation for failure to comply with the requirements of the California Safe Drinking Water Act, or any regulation, standard, permit or order issued thereunder.

VIOLATION

The Drinking Water Field Operations Branch of the Department of Public Health, (hereinafter Department) hereby issues a citation to the Glenview Mobile Park (hereinafter GMP) for the following violation:



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1. Section 64423, Title 22, CCR. Specifically, the GMP failed to collect and/or report a routine distribution coliform sample for the month of June 2013.

BACKGROUND

The GMP is a community water system as it serves approximately 125 people through 25 service connections. The system water supply is obtained from one active well (Well No. 02), which is 550 feet deep and has an 8-inch diameter steel casing. The perforations begin at 400 feet. The well has an annular cement seal depth of 370 feet. The water is pumped to a storage tank of 4,500 gallons and then boosted to the distribution system. The well is chlorinated prior to storage.

The Total Coliform Rule requires the GMP to collect one routine coliform sample every month from the system. During the month of June 2013, the GMP failed to collect and/or report the required routine coliform sample, which resulted in non-compliance with Section 64423, Title 22, CCR.

DIRECTIVES

The GMP is hereby directed to take the following actions:

1. Immediately, follow proper TCR routine and repeat sampling/reporting procedures in accordance with Article 3, Title 22, CCR, Sections 64423, 64424.
2. The system shall notify the public of the monitoring failure to collect and analyze the required routine bacteriological distribution sample for the months of June 2012 and June 2013. Required public notification for the June 2012 failure was not provided. The GMP must provide notice to each customer by October 1, 2013.
