The State Water Resources Control Board, Division of Drinking Water (hereinafter Division) hereby issues a citation to the Conservation Endowment Fund (hereinafter CEF) (mailing address: 2158 Baldwin Road, CA 93023) for the following violation:

1. Section 116650 of Chapter 4, Part 12, Division 104 of the California Health and Safety Code (H&S Code), authorizes the issuance of a citation for failure to comply with the requirements of the California Safe Drinking Water Act, or any regulation, standard, permit or order issued thereunder.

**VIOLATION**

1. Section 64423, Title 22, CCR. Specifically, the CEF failed to collect and/or report a routine distribution coliform sample for the period of July 2015 through September 2015.

## BACKGROUND

The CEF serves approximately eight permanent residents, 10 to 15 maintenance workers, and about 100 visitors (during events) through 30 connections. The CEF's water supply is obtained from Well 01. The source provides a source capacity of three to five gallons per minute and is not chlorinated. The well is located more than 150 feet from a creek and complies with the primary drinking water standards. The CEF utilizes one 10,000 gallon steel storage tank which provides pressure, via gravity, to the distribution system.

The CEF is required to collect, at a minimum, one quarterly routine coliform sample from the distribution system. The CEF failed to collect and/or report the routine coliform sample for **July 2015 through September 2015**. This has resulted in a procedural failure and violation of Section 64423 and 64451 of the California Code of Regulations, Title 22, CCR.

## DIRECTIVES

The CEF is hereby directed to take the following actions:

1. Immediately, follow proper TCR routine and repeat sampling/reporting procedures in accordance with Article 3, Title 22, CCR, Sections 64423, 64424. Collect a coliform sample within 30 days from the date of this notice to make up for the missed sample. In addition, take the routine quarterly sample prior to December 31, 2015.





2. Within 30 days of receipt of this violation, notify the public of the failure to collect and analyze the required routine bacteriological distribution sample for the months of **July 2015 through September 2015** by direct delivery and posting in conspicuous public places served by the water system.
