## **Citation for Noncompliance Nitrite Monitoring and Reporting Violation Issued: August 24, 2016**

In accordance with Chapter 4, Article 9, Section 116650 of Part 1 of Division 104 of the California Health and Safety Code (CHSC), this Division is authorized to issue a citation for failure to comply with a requirement of Chapter 4 (California Safe Drinking Water Act), or any regulation, standard, permit or order issued thereunder.

### **Violation**

The Yolo County Environmental Health Division (Division) hereby issues a citation to Clarksburg Community Church for failure to comply with Section 116555(a) of the CHSC and Section 64432.1 of Title 22, California Code of Regulations (CCR). Specifically Clarksburg Community Church failed to collect and/or report the required number of Nitrite water samples for 2012 and 2015.

In accordance with Section 64432.1(a), Clarksburg Community Church is required to collect and have analyzed for Nitrite, one sample from its source every three calendar years. As of this date, the Division has not received any results for a Nitrite sample taken during the compliance period(s): 2012 and 2015.

### **Directives**

Clarksburg Community Church is hereby directed to take the following actions:

1. Comply with Section 64432.1 in all future monitoring periods.
2. Notify all persons served by the Clarksburg Community Church water system of this violation by completing, posting, and returning a copy of *Attachment A* by **August 31, 2016**. This notice must include a written or typed description of corrective actions taken by the water system to prevent this violation from occurring in the future.
3. Complete delinquent monitoring and provide the Division with results by **Tuesday, September 6, 2016**.

**Civil Penalty**

Sections 116650(d) and 116650(e) of CHSC allow for assessment of a civil penalty for failure to comply with requirements of Chapter 4. Failure to comply with any provision of this citation may result in the Division imposing a civil penalty not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000) per day. A separate penalty may be assessed for each violation.

Under the Yolo County Ordinance, preparation of this citation will be billed at \$152 per hour to the water system. An invoice for one hour of report writing will be billed to the water system account in the month of September 2016 and is due upon receipt.

The Clarksburg Community Church water system failed to monitor as required for drinking water standards during the past year and, therefore, was in violation of the regulations. Even though this failure was not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know what you should do, what happened, and what we did to correct this situation.

*We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During the compliance periods, 2012 and 2015, we did not monitor or test for nitrite and therefore, cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.*

#### What should I do?

- There is nothing you need to do at this time.
- The table below lists the contaminant(s) we did not properly test for during the aforementioned compliance period, how many samples we are required to take and how often, how many samples we took, when samples should have been taken, and the date on which follow-up samples were (or will be) taken.
