**Background:** The Santa Clara River Valley study unit includes the DWR-defined groundwater basins of Santa Clara River Valley, Pleasant valley, Las Posas Valley, and Ventura River Valley. The state legislature required that the State Water Board develop a comprehensive ambient groundwater quality monitoring plan. The GAMA Program was created as a result of groundwater quality concerns. The main objectives of the GAMA Program are to improve statewide ambient groundwater quality monitoring and assessment and to increase the availability of information about groundwater quality to the public. Stewardship of the state's groundwater resources is the shared responsibility of all levels of the government and community. Participation in the GAMA Program is voluntary.




**Directions to the Ventura County Government Center:**

Those coming from Oxnard, Thousand Oaks, or Simi Valley via the 101 Freeway northbound should use the Victoria Avenue exit, and drive north about 3/4 mile to the complex

If coming from Fillmore or Santa Paula, use the Victoria Avenue southbound exit from the 126 Freeway.

From the north or west, it is easiest to take Highway 126 east from the 101 Freeway, and then use the Victoria Avenue southbound exit.
