

**Background:** The Upper Los Angeles Basin study unit includes the DWR-defined San Gabriel Valley, Raymond, and San Fernando Valley basins. The state legislature required that the State Water Board develop a comprehensive ambient groundwater quality monitoring plan. The GAMA Program was created as a result of groundwater quality concerns. The main objectives of the GAMA Program are to improve statewide ambient groundwater quality monitoring and assessment and to increase the availability of information about groundwater quality to the public. Stewardship of the state's groundwater resources is the shared responsibility of all levels of the government and community. Participation in the GAMA Program is voluntary.



**Directions to the Southern District office:**

From the North:

Take Interstate 5 south then the 134 freeway east. Exit at San Fernando Road. Turn right at bottom of the off-ramp. Turn right at San Fernando Road. Turn right at Fairmont Avenue. The office is on the right side after the first stop sign.

From the South:
