RE: Request for an Extension of the Submittal Due Date for the Final Arimol Wetlands Surface Water Restoration Work Plan Scheduled for Friday, November 8th 2013.

Permission for culvert and headwall removal at the Arimol site has been issued and we are in the final stages of revising and finalizing the Arimol Wetlands Surface Water Restoration Plan while incorporating the information gathered during recent discussions, emails, meetings, telephone calls and the Notice of Violation dated October 29, 2013, while addressing the recently stated concerns of the RWQCB, CDFW and San Bernardino County. We are in the process of preparing the final Arimol Wetlands Restoration Plan and because of the confusion and unforeseen delays created by the multitudes of emails, telephone calls, differing permit requirements, correspondence, the NOV, form filling, and related documentation pertaining the wetlands restoration project up to this point in time. Due to these events, in addition to the complications relating to our acquisition of County permits for culvert and headwall removal while addressing the concerns provided in the RWQCB's response letter of October 4, 2013, and subsequent CDFW inquiries/requests in tandem with conducting the preparation of the final Arimol Wetlands Surface Water Restoration Plan for submittal to the Lahontan Regional Water Quality Control Board's (RWQCB) Advisory Team and CDFW on Friday, November 8, 2013, we are respectfully requesting that the submittal deadline be extended for several more weeks, if at all possible. The extra time will enable us to better address and incorporate the high volume of information and ensure that the accuracy and quality of the document, responses to the RWQCB, CDFW, and San Bernardino County meet the expectations of all stakeholders.

I apologize for the last minute submittal of this extension request. Despite our intent to address this important matter earlier in the week, an unusually high volume of other work related issues contributed to this "slipping-through-the cracks." The fault is all ours and not that of our client, Mr. Bill Moeller.
