Description of Work Performed, Other Details	Under direction of Susanville CSD, Kennedy Jenks Consultants successfully installed the following: chlorine destruction pond to remove a possible toxicant; three emergency storage ponds to store raw sewage water during plant shutdowns, power outages, and wet-season peak flow; and constructed wetland for additional nitrate and phosphate removal. Only the wetland was funded under the SEP.
