## SUBJECT: Public Meeting Regarding Reconsideration Marina del Rey Harbor Toxic Pollutants TMDLs

The Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Los Angeles Water Board) invites stakeholders and interested parties to a public meeting on **Wednesday**, **October 25**, **2023 at 2:00 pm** to discuss reconsideration of the Marina del Rey Harbor Toxic Pollutants Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL). This meeting will be held **virtually**. The purpose of the meeting is to solicit public participation as the Los Angeles Water Board begins the reconsideration of this TMDL. In 2024, the Los Angeles Water Board will consider amendments to the *Water Quality Control Plan for the Los Angeles Region* (Basin Plan) to incorporate any revisions to the TMDLs.

At the meeting, Los Angeles Water Board staff will discuss monitoring results and the results of a water effects ratio special study which may be used to adopt a site-specific objective for copper in Marina del Rey Harbor. The reconsideration schedule will also be discussed.
