TRASH TMDL FROM THE OCTOBER 24, 2006 REGIONAL BOARD
MEETING AGENDA

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region, was scheduled to consider a proposed TMDL for trash in the Los Angeles River Watershed during its October 24, 2006 Board meeting. This notice informs interested parties that the proposed Basin Plan Amendment to adopt a Los Angeles River Watershed Trash TMDL has been removed from the agenda of the October 24, 2006 Regional Board Meeting, and therefore will not be heard at this time. Under section 21159 of the Public Resources Code, an agency's environmental analysis must include an analysis of a reasonable range of specific sites. While the draft environmental documents did analyze site-specific impacts, it did not make reference to specific sites. Among the many comments received on this matter, one comment objected in this regard. Accordingly, a site-specific analysis will be prepared and circulated in short order.
