DESCRIPTION OF NATURE, PURPOSE, AND BENEFICIARIES OF PROJECT:
 This project involves the installation of pollution abatement devices and appurtenant structures into existent storm drains at two locations within the upper Los Angeles River watershed. Four devices are to be installed in the City-owned storm drain at the Canoga Avenue location, while one device is to be installed, along with a diversion pipe, in the County-owned storm drain at the Van Nuys Boulevard location. The trash-removal devices are designed to reduce storm drain runoff pollution in compliance with National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit requirements.



PROJECT LOCATION: The project is located at the terminus of Enterprise Street in the Central City North community, in Los Angeles

DESCRIPTION OF NATURE, PURPOSE, AND BENEFICIARIES OF PROJECT:

Installation of a low flow diversion structure in Enterprise Street east of Santa Fe Avenue on the 8th Street storm drain system. The low flow from this drain is currently being diverted with a temporary system at a rate of 300 gpm by a 7.5 hp pump. The permanent low flow diversion will consist of a trash collection MH, a pump well with a duplex pump system, a valve vault, a discharge line connecting to a nearby sanitary sewer, a bypass line back to the existing storm drain, and a local control system.

The project will benefit the community and the general public.



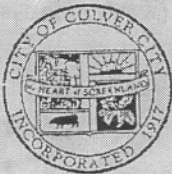

This is considered Package 1 of Phase I implementation of Trash Total Maximum Daily Loads Order (Trash TMDL). The purpose of the TMDLs is to attain the water quality standards for trash in the Los Angeles River and Bellona Creek and to enhance water quality in the both water sheds. Implementation involves design, construction and O&M of trash capture devices which will be placed at the ends (outfalls) of the existing storm drain systems on the freeways and in other Caltrans facilities such as maintenance stations and Park & Rides.
