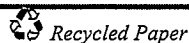
Dear Interested Parties:

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Regional Board) will reconsider two proposed amendments to the *Water Quality Control Plan for the Los Angeles Region* (Basin Plan) to incorporate Total Maximum Daily Loads (TMDLs) to reduce metals loadings to the Los Angeles River and its tributaries and to Ballona Creek and its tributaries. Additional regulations or policies, consistent with the general purpose of the proposed amendment and complementary to the proposal may be developed at the hearing as a logical outgrowth of discussions. The Regional Board will act on the proposed amendment after hearing staff's presentation and public comments. In response to stakeholder request, the public hearing location has been changed. This board meeting, which the public hearing will be a part of, will be held on September 6, 2007 at 9:00 AM at the:
