

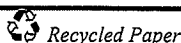
This notice is to advise any interested parties that the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region, will consider adoption of an amendment to the Water Quality Control Plan to revise the waste load allocation in the TMDL for Nitrogen Compounds and Related Effects in the Calleguas Creek Watershed as adopted by the Regional Board in Resolution 02-017. Consideration of the proposed resolution will be at a public hearing to be held on September 11, 2008 at 9:00 A.M., in the Board Room of the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California, 700 N. Alameda Street, Los Angeles, California. Actions to amend the Water Quality Control Plan for the Los Angeles Region will be taken in accordance with a regulatory program exempt under Section 21080.5 of the Public Resources Code from the requirement to prepare an environmental impact report under the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resources Code Section 21000 et seq.) and with other applicable laws and regulations.
