

LOCATION: Los Angeles Region (Colorado Lagoon Watershed)

DESCRIPTION: Proposed Basin Plan Amendment to incorporate a Total Maximum Daily Load for Organochlorine (OC) Pesticides, Polychlorinated Biphenyls (PCBs), Sediment Toxicity, Polycyclic Aromatic Hydrocarbons (PAHs), and Metals for Colorado Lagoon Watershed.

This notice is to advise any interested parties that the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region, will consider adoption of an amendment to the Water Quality Control Plan to incorporate a Total Maximum Daily Load for OC Pesticides, PCBs, Sediment Toxicity, PAHs, and Metals for Colorado Lagoon Watershed. Consideration of the proposed amendment will be at a public hearing to be held on October 1, 2009 at 9:00 a.m. in the Board Room of the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California, 700 N. Alameda Street, Los Angeles, California.

Actions to amend the Water Quality Control Plan for the Los Angeles Region will be taken in accordance with a regulatory program exempt under Section 21080.5 of the Public Resources Code from the requirement to prepare an environmental impact report under the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resources Code Section 21000 et seq.) and with other applicable laws and regulations.
