V. Data Gaps and Additional Monitoring: Peter Kozelka, USEPA

- SCCWRP will conduct additional sampling for DOC, POC, bulk sediment and pore water and overlying water chemistry to calculate sediment Koc values and flux rates from sediment to water
- Three (3) times at one (1) highly contaminated location, probably Consolidated Slip
- One (1) time at (as many as) 12 other locations for spatial representation, probably at Bight 2003 sampling locations. **SCCWRP has requested input on these supplemental stations
- Sampling results submitted by September 2006 will be used in the model development and TMDL decisions for RB adoption in 2008
- Monitoring results collected after this date may be used to refine the models at some future date and may influence post-TMDL decisions, but will not affect TMDL to be adopted in 2008
