
Dear Dr. Nye and Mr. Voong:

The City of Inglewood (City) writes to notify you that the proposed Los Angeles River Bacteria TMDL staff report identifies the City as being located within the Los Angeles River system – specifically through the Compton Creek tributary. This is indicated in *Table 9-1, Responsible Parties for Waste Load Allocations Assigned in the Los Angeles River Bacteria TMDL*.

The City, however, is not aware that it partially drains into Compton Creek. The City is only aware that it drains to Dominguez Channel primarily, and to Ballona Creek to a lesser extent. If you have information indicating that the City partially drains to Compton Creek, please provide that information to the City. If such information is not available, please remove the City from Table 9-1.
