### History of Marina del Rey Harbor Toxics TMDL

TMDL Adopted October 6, 2005

Addressed sediment in back basins TMDL

Revised


February 6, 2014

Expanded to address water column and front basins Dissolved Copper Compliance Deadline March 22, 2024 Marina del Rey Harbor Toxic Pollutants TMDL: Dissolved Copper

Numeric Target: acute 4.8 µg/L, chronic 3.1 µg/L

Load Allocation: 85% reduction in the baseline copper load from boats

## Purpose of Workshop

Consider County of Los Angeles's proposed study to calculate a site-specific objective (SSO) for dissolved copper in Marina del Rey Harbor

Initiating an SSO Study: The State Implementation Policy (SIP)

#### **SIP Section 5.2 Site-Specific Objectives**

"...the RWQCB shall, at a public meeting, consider initiating the development of a site-specific objective under the following conditions:

# Summary: SIP SSO Policy

(1) A written request for a site-specific study, accompanied by a preliminary commitment to fund the study; and(2)Either:

- a priority pollutant criterion or objective is not achieved; or
- a holder of an NPDES permit demonstrates they do not, or may not in the future, meet an existing or potential effluent limitation; and

3) A demonstration that the discharger cannot be assured of achieving the criterion or objective and/or effluent limitation through reasonable treatment, source control, and pollution prevention measures
