TENTATIVE ORDER TO TERMINATE WATER RECLAMATION REQUIREMENTS FOR LOS ANGELES COUNTY PROBATION DEPARTMENT AND LOS ANGELES COUNTY INTERNAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT – CAMPS AFFLERBAUGH AND PAIGE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT, 6631 NORTH STEPHENS RANCH ROAD, LA VERNE, CALIFORNIA (ORDER NO. 95-163, FILE NO. 58-153, CI NO. 6370, GLOBAL ID WDR1000001060)

Dear Mr. Tizani:

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Regional Board), is the public agency with primary responsibility for the protection of ground and surface water quality for all beneficial uses of water within major portions of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, including the facility mentioned above.

On November 6, 1995, Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Regional Board) adopted Water Reclamation Requirements Order No. 95-163 (WRRs), and the associated Monitoring and Reporting Program, CI No. 6370 for the Los Angeles County Probation Department and the Los Angeles County Internal Services (Dischargers) for the discharge and recycled water use of treated wastewater generated from the Camps Afflerbaugh and Paige Wastewater Treatment Plant (Plant) located at 6631 North Stephens Ranch Road, La Verne, California.

On June 23, 2015, the Dischargers requested that the Regional Board terminate Order No. 95-163, since the Afflerbaugh and Paige Camps have connected to the City of La Verne sewer systems on September 30, 2013, and water reclamation requirements are no longer needed at the facility.

In accordance with administrative procedures, this Regional Board, at a public hearing, will consider the enclosed tentative Order, which will terminate WRRs Order No. 95-163. The hearing will be held at 9:00 a.m. on **July 14, 2016**, at the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California, 700 North Alameda Street, Los Angeles, California.

In order to be fully evaluated by Regional Board staff and included in the Board's agenda packet, written comments must be received at the Regional Board office by 5:00 p.m. on June 13, 2016. Failure to comply with these requirements is grounds for the Board to refuse to admit

the proposed written comment or exhibit into evidence. Timely submittal of written comments is encouraged to ensure that all comments are accurately and fully included in the administrative record, that Board staff is able to provide a timely review, and that Regional Board Members have sufficient time to give full consideration to the comments and issues raised.
