TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS, MONITORING AND REPORTING PROGRAM, AND CEASE AND DESIST ORDER FOR FORESTER AND FIRE WARDEN CAMP 13 WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT, 1250 SOUTH ENCINAL CANYON ROAD, MALIBU, CALIFORNIA (FILE NO. 61-108, CI-3138, GLOBAL ID WDR100001048)

Dear Mr. Tizani,

This letter is a revision to the letter sent to you on April 17, 2015, clarifying the written comment requirements. The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Regional Board), is the state agency with primary responsibility for the protection of ground and surface water quality for all beneficial uses within major portions of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, including the referenced property above.

On July 27, 2000, the Regional Board adopted Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) Order No. 00-110 for Forester and Fire Warden Camp 13 wastewater treatment plant. Pursuant to the California Water Code, all waste discharge requirements are reviewed periodically, and, upon such review, may be revised by the Regional Board. Following a review of the existing requirements contained in WDR Order No. 00-110, a tentative Order for WDRs, a tentative monitoring and reporting program (MRP), and a tentative Cease and Desist Order (CDO) have been prepared.

Enclosed are copies of the following:

1. Tentative Waste Discharge Requirements consisting of:
 - a. Tentative Order No. R4-2015-XXXX, specifying Waste Discharge Requirements,
 - b. Tentative Standard Provisions Applicable to Waste Discharge Requirements, and
 - c. Tentative Monitoring and Reporting Program No. CI-3138.
2. Tentative Cease and Desist Order No. R4-2015-XXXX.

In accordance with administrative procedures, the Regional Board will consider the enclosed tentative WDRs, tentative CDO, and comments thereon, at a public hearing to be held at 9:00 AM on June 11, 2015, at the Board Room, Metropolitan Water District of Southern California located at 700 North Alameda Street, Los Angeles, California. The Regional Board will hear any testimony pertinent to this discharge, the tentative requirements, monitoring and reporting program. It is expected that the Regional Board will take action at the hearing; however, as testimony indicates, the Regional Board at its discretion may postpone action. See enclosed Notice of Opportunity to Comment and Public Hearing.

Written comments or testimony regarding these tentative WDRs and CDO must be received at the Regional Board's Office by **5:00 PM on May 18, 2015**. Comments received after this date will not be accepted into the record unless determined by the Chair of the Regional Board not to prejudice any party or the Regional Board.

Standard Provisions, which are part of these tentative requirements, are enclosed for the addressee only. However, these are on file in the Regional Board's Office, and a copy will be sent to anyone else upon request.
