**REVISED TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND TITLE 22 WATER RECYCLING REQUIREMENTS (WRRs), AND RESPONSE TO COMMENTS – UNITED STATES NAVY, SAN CLEMENTE ISLAND WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT (FILE NO. 04-035, CI-8734)**

On April 29, 2015, the Regional Water Board staff distributed the revised tentative WDRs and WRRs; however, three minor corrections have been made since its distribution. A copy of the new revised tentative Order and written responses to all comments received are enclosed. Changes to the tentative WDRs and WRRs appear in strikeout and underline format. Written comments are not being solicited regarding the revised tentative Order.
