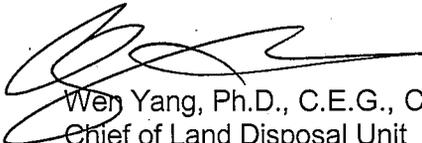

Reference is made to our letter dated April 9, 2012, indicating that this Regional Water Quality Control Board intends to revise the Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for the Toyon Canyon Landfill (Regional Board Order No. R4-2002-0076, adopted on March 28, 2002).
