
Our letter dated December 3, 2014, transmitted the tentative Order for renewal of the permit to discharge wastes under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES). January 9, 2015, was the deadline for comments on the proposed Order. On that day the Regional Water Board staff (staff) received comments (they have been posted on our web site) via emails.
