REVISED TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – CAMARILLO SANITARY DISTRICT WATER RECLAMATION PLANT (NPDES NO. CA0053597, CI NO. 1278)

Reference is made to our letter dated March 24, 2011, which:

1. Informed interested parties about a proposed change to the final water quality based effluent limitations (WQBELs) for copper in section IV.A.1.a of the revised tentative Order that resulted as an outgrowth of comments received from Camarillo Sanitary District (hereafter Camarillo SD or District) in its comment letter dated March 18, 2011;
2. Extended the comment period to 12 p.m. (noon) on March 30, 2011, with respect to the proposed final copper WQBELs; and,
3. Communicated that written responses to all comments received by the March 21, 2011, noon comment deadline and a revised tentative permit will be forthcoming in separate correspondence.

Enclosed please find the revised tentative Order with changes shown in strikeout and underline format, and the response to comments table. Additional comments are not being solicited at this time, since the comment deadline period lapsed.

In accordance with administrative procedures, this Board at a public hearing to be held on April 14, 2011, at 9:00 a.m., at the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California Board Room, 700 North Alameda Street, Los Angeles, California, will consider the revised tentative waste discharge requirements. The Board will hear any oral testimony and comments pertinent to this discharge and the revised tentative requirements. It is expected that the Board will take action at the hearing; however, as testimony indicates, the Board, at its discretion, may order further investigation.
