RESPONSE TO COMMENTS FOR THE TENTATIVE TIME SCHEDULE ORDER (TSO) AND REVISED TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) – CITY OF REDONDO BEACH – SEASIDE LAGOON (NPDES NO. CA0064297, CI NO. 8034)

Thank you for your letter that the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) received by email on May 5, 2017. We realize that Seaside Lagoon is a unique and important recreational amenity in your city. We have carefully considered your comments and appreciate your staff's efforts in working with us on the development of the revised permit. We believe that our revisions will ensure that the Seaside Lagoon provides a safe water recreational area for its guests and will protect the beneficial uses of King Harbor.

As requested, the staff of the Regional Water Board, has revised the effective and expiration dates in the Revised Tentative WDRs and National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Order. The effective date of the NPDES permit has been changed to October 1, 2017, after the closure of Seaside Lagoon for the 2017 operating season. The expiration date of the NPDES permit has been changed to September 30, 2022, following the 2022 operating season. The NPDES permit and Time Schedule Order (TSO) are scheduled to be considered by the Regional water Board at its regularly scheduled meeting on June 1, 2017, at the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California Board Room, 700 North Alameda Street, Los Angeles, California.
