## NOTICE OF POSTPONEMENT & CONTINUANCE; RESPONSE TO COMMENTS; AND REVISED TENTATIVE AMENDMENT OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs)/ NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – CITY OF THOUSAND OAKS, HILL CANYON WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT (NPDES NO. CA0056294, R4-2014-0064-A0X, CI-4917)

On September 11, 2017, the Regional Water Board staff prepared tentative Amendment Order No. R4-2014-0064-AXX for the Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) and National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for the Hill Canyon Wastewater Treatment Plant (Hill Canyon WWTP), in accordance with the narrow permit reopener contained in section VI.C.1.i of the current NPDES Order.

Regional Water Board staff considered comments received by the October 11, 2017, public comment deadline and prepared the enclosed written response to comments table and Revised Tentative Amendment Order R4-2014-0064-AXX. The changes that were made, in response to the comments received, appear in underline and double strikeout format, with the text highlighted in yellow.

Please be advised that the scheduled board hearing for the adoption of the Revised Tentative Amendment Order for the City of Thousand Oaks' Hill Canyon WWTP permit has been <u>postponed and continued</u> to the **December 7, 2017,** board meeting. Although the date has changed, the venue will remain the same.

In accordance with administrative procedures, this Board at a public hearing to be held on **December 7, 2017**, at **9:00 a.m**., at the **Metropolitan Water District of Southern California Board Room, 700 North Alameda Street, Los Angeles, California**, will consider the enclosed Revised Tentative Amendment Requirements and comments submitted in writing regarding the proposed Revised Tentative Amendment NPDES Order. The Board will hear any testimony pertinent to this discharge and the revised tentative requirements. It is expected that the Board will take action at the hearing; however, as testimony indicates, the Board, at its discretion, may order further action by staff. The agenda for the meeting will be posted on the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board's website
