**REVISED TENTATIVE AMENDMENT OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT AND RESPONSE TO COMMENTS FOR JOINT OUTFALL SYSTEM, WHITTIER NARROWS WATER RECLAMATION PLANT (NPDES NO. CA0053716 CI NO. 2848)**

We have revised the tentative amendment of the WDRs and NPDES permit dated May 6, 2015. A copy of the revised tentative amended Order and written responses to all comments received are enclosed. The only change to the tentative amended WDRs is found on page F-4, section 1.D of the Fact Sheet. No other changes were made on the tentative amended permit. Written comments are not being solicited regarding the revised tentative amendment.

In accordance with administrative procedures, the Los Angeles Regional Water Board at a public hearing to be held on **July 9, 2015, at 9:00 a.m., at the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California Board Room, 700 North Alameda Street, Los Angeles, California**, will consider the enclosed revised tentative requirements and comments submitted in writing regarding the revised tentative amended Order. The Board will hear any testimony pertinent to this revised tentative amended Order. It is expected that the Board will take action at the hearing; however, as testimony indicates, the Board, at its discretion, may order further action by staff.
