TRANSMITTAL OF AMENDED TIME SCHEDULE ORDER (TSO) NO. R4-2013-0026-A1 REQUIRING CHEVRON PRODUCTS COMPANY, EL SEGUNDO REFINERY TO COMPLY WITH REQUIREMENTS PRESCRIBED IN ORDER NO. R4-2013-0025 — CHEVRON PRODUCTS COMPANY, EL SEGUNDO REFINERY, EL SEGUNDO, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CA0000337, CI NO. 1603)

Dear Ms. Worley:

On September 15, 2016, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Regional Water Board) provided the Discharger and interested parties with an opportunity to comment on the amended tentative Time Schedule Order (TSO) No. R4-2013-0026-AX, which proposed to extend the time schedule in the TSO adopted on February 7, 2013, to comply with the final limitation for acute toxicity by eight months. On October 14, 2016, the Regional Water Board received comments on the tentative amended TSO from Heal the Bay. In a Response to Comments letter issued to Heal the Bay dated November 18, 2016, Regional Water Board staff provided clarification for the issues raised in the comment letter. The responses included did not require modifications to the tentative TSO.

As per the Notice of Proposed Issuance of the TSO, the Executive Officer, pursuant to his delegated authority from the Regional Water Board issued the Amended Time Schedule Order No. R4-2013-0026-A1. The TSO Amendment became effective on the date of issuance and it expires on January 10, 2018.
