### **TENTATIVE TIME SCHEDULE ORDER (TSO) FOR NRG CALIFORNIA SOUTH LP MANDALAY GENERATING STATION, OXNARD, CA. (NPDES NO. CA0001180, CI NO. 2093).**

We have reviewed your letter dated October 1, 2015, requesting a Time Schedule Order (TSO) to come into compliance with the discharge limitations contained in the waste discharge requirements (WDRs) and National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit, Order No. R4-2015-0201 (NPDES Permit No. CA0001180). Order No. R4-2015-0201 regulates the discharge of wastewater to surface waters from NRG California South LP, Mandalay Generating Station Facility.

NRG California South LP cannot consistently meet the effluent limitations for pH contained in Order No. R4-2015-0201 for discharges from the retention basins and boiler blowdown. Therefore, a tentative TSO has been developed with interim limitations for pH that will expire on July 2, 2016. This TSO will provide the required time to make infrastructure changes and implement appropriate control measures to bring the Mandalay Generating Station discharge into compliance with the final pH limitations. Attached is the tentative TSO.

In accordance with administrative procedures, this Board at a public hearing to be held on December 10, 2015, at 9:00 A.M., at Metropolitan Water District of Southern California Board Room, 700 North Alameda Street, Los Angeles, California, will consider the enclosed tentative TSO and comments submitted in writing regarding any and all portions thereof. The Board members will hear any testimony pertinent to this tentative TSO. It is expected that the Board will take action at the hearing; however, as testimony indicates, the Board, at its discretion, may order further investigation.

Written submissions pertaining to this proposed Board action must be submitted to the Regional Water Board staff at [losangeles@waterboards.ca.gov](mailto:losangeles@waterboards.ca.gov) with a copy submitted to Rosario Aston at [Rosario.Aston@waterboards.ca.gov](mailto:Rosario.Aston@waterboards.ca.gov) no later than 5:00 p.m. on **November 16, 2015**, in order to be evaluated by Board staff and included in the Board's agenda folder. Timely submittal of written comments is encouraged to ensure that Regional Water Board staff is able to provide timely review, and that Regional Water Board members have sufficient time to give full consideration to

the comments and issues raised. The Regional Water Board chair may exclude from the record written materials received after this date. (See Cal. Code Regs., tit. 23, § 648.4.)

With respect to the public notices, in accordance with the Federal Clean Water Act, as amended, and the California Code of Regulations, you are required to follow the enclosed instructions for publication or posting of the notice no later than October 16, 2015.

Please notify this Regional Water Board by telephone when the notice has been published and submit the proof of publication or posting as required in the enclosed instructions. Proof of posting or publication of the notice must be received by the Executive Officer of this Regional Water Board no later than October 30, 2015.
