NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON THE PROPOSED MODIFICATIONS TO THE BEACH CITIES WATERSHED MANAGEMENT GROUP'S COORDINATED INTEGRATED MONITORING PROGRAM PURSUANT TO THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY MUNICIPAL SEPARATE STORM SEWER SYSTEM (MS4) PERMIT (NPDES PERMIT NO. CAS004001; ORDER NO. R4-2012-0175 AS AMENDED BY STATE WATER BOARD ORDER WQ 2015-0075 AND LOS ANGELES WATER BOARD ORDER NO. R4-2012-

0175-A01)

On August 25, 2015, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Los Angeles Water Board or Board) approved the Beach Cities Watershed Management Group (Group) Coordinated Integrated Monitoring Program (CIMP).

On August 1, 2018, the Group submitted a request to revise their CIMP as follows:

- Revise the list of monitoring parameters based on the most recently approved State's 2016 303(d) list by adding mercury and arsenic to monitoring sites within Santa Monica Bay Watershed and removing ammonia from monitoring sites within the Dominguez Channel Watershed.
- Relocate stormwater outfall monitoring station OF-BCEG-2 to a more representative downstream location that captures a larger tributary area.
- Substitute stormwater outfall monitoring locations OF-BCEG-3 and OF-BCEG-4 with a new monitoring location at OF-BCEG-4a.
