COORDINATED INTEGRATED MONITORING PROGRAM SEMI-ANNUAL DATA SUBMISSION**

Dear Mr. Unger and Ms. Purdy:

Pursuant to Part XIV.L, of the Attachment E Monitoring and Reporting Plan, to California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (LARWQCB) Order No. R4-2012-0175, as amended by State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) Order WQ 2015-0075, the Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4), National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES), Permit No. CAS004001; CWE is pleased to submit the enclosed Rio Hondo/San Gabriel River (RH/SGR) Water Quality Group (WQG) Coordinated Integrated Monitoring Program (CIMP) Semi-Annual Summary Data Report on behalf of the MS4 Permittee Cities of Arcadia (4B190149001), Azusa (4B190151001), Bradbury (4B190155001), Duarte (4B190168001), Monrovia (4B190193001), Sierra Madre (4B190209001), the County of Los Angeles (4B190107099), and the Los Angeles County Flood Control District (4B190107101), identified collectively as the Rio Hondo/San Gabriel River (RH/SGR) Water Quality Group (WQG). Based on the suggestions of Board Staff, this submission follows SWRCB California Environmental Data Exchange Network (CEDEN), rather than Stormwater Monitoring Coalition (SMC) Standard Data Transfer Format (SDTF), conventions.


The June 29, 2015, letter conveying LARWQCB Executive Officer approval, directed that the RH/SGR WQG commence CIMP implementation by September 27, 2015. At the direction of the WQG, and using the RHSGR WQG CIMP for guidance, CWE undertook the following water quality monitoring events during the reporting period for June to December 2015:

- Dry-Weather Water Quality Monitoring Event #1 occurred on September 21, 2015 at the
  - RHSGR\_RH3\_ARC and RHSGR\_LDW\_BDW Long Term Assessment (LTA) receiving water sites
  - RHSGR\_SAN\_DD and RHSGR\_SAW\_PR Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) receiving water sites
- Wet-Weather Water Quality Monitoring Event #1 occurred on October 4, 2015 at the
  - RHSGR\_RH3\_ARC, RHSGR\_LDW\_BDW, RHSGR\_SAN\_DD, and RHSGR\_SAW\_PR sites
  - RHSGR\_PRD and RHSGR\_BRD Stormwater Outfall Based Monitoring sites
