SUBMITTAL OF SEMI-ANNUAL REPORT (JULY 1 – DECEMBER 31, 2015) MARINA DEL REY COORDINATED INTEGRATED MONITORING PROGRAM

This letter serves to notify the California Regional Water Quality Control Board – Los Angeles (Regional Board) that the County of Los Angeles, Los Angeles County Flood Control District, and the cities of Los Angeles and Culver City (collectively the Marina del Rey (MdR) agencies) are not submitting a 2016 Semi-Annual Report.

Pursuant to Part XIV.L of the Monitoring and Reporting Program of the Los Angeles County Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System Permit (Order No. R4-2012-0175), results of monitoring from receiving water or outfall based monitoring are to be submitted semi-annually to the Regional Board upon approval of a Coordinated Integrated Monitoring Program (CIMP). However, since the Marina del Rey CIMP plan was not approved until May 23, 2016, the MdR agencies did not carryout monitoring activities between July 1 – December 31, 2015.
