**SUBJECT: Submittal of 2017-2018 Semi Annual Report for the Los Cerritos Channel Watershed Coordinated Integrated Monitoring Program (3<sup>rd</sup> Year Monitoring)**

The Los Cerritos Channel (LCC) Watershed Group are submitting the Semi-Annual Report for the Coordinated Integrated Monitoring Program for the 2017-2018 (3<sup>rd</sup> Year). Included are monitoring data results for the period of July 1, 2017 to December 31, 2017. This data report is being submitted in the California Environmental Data Exchange Network (CEDEN) format. The Los Cerritos Channel Watershed Group consists of the following participants: Bellflower, Cerritos, Downey, Lakewood, Long Beach, Paramount, Signal Hill, and the Los Angeles County Flood Control District. This report is being submitted for the LCC Watershed Group by Kinnetic Laboratories, Inc. who has been contracted by the Watershed Group to carry out the monitoring program.

Between the reporting period of July 1 through December 31, 2017 the following events were conducted:

- On July 20, 2017, KLI performed dry weather sampling at LCC1 for the E2 list of analytes.
- No wet weather sampling events were conducted at any of the seven stations during this period.

The information is submitted pursuant to Part XIV.L of the Monitoring and Reporting Program of the Los Angeles County Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) Permit (NPDES Permit No. CAS004001; Order No. R4-2012-0175). The second associated Data Deliverable file is a ZIP file with all the Semi-Annual data included as EXCEL files for the period of July 1 to December 31, 2017 for the Los Cerritos Channel Watershed CIMP program
