SUBJECT: Submittal of 2017-2018 Semi Annual Report for the Lower Los Angeles River Watershed Coordinated Integrated Monitoring Program (3rd Year Monitoring)

The Lower Los Angeles River (LLAR) Watershed Group are submitting the Semi-Annual Report for the Coordinated Integrated Monitoring Program for the 2017-2018 (3rd Year). Included are monitoring data results for the period of July 1, to December 31, 2017. This data report is being submitted in the California Environmental Data Exchange Network (CEDEN) format. The Lower Los Angeles River Watershed Group consists of the following participants: Downey, Lakewood, Long Beach, Lynwood, Pico Rivera, Signal Hill, South Gate, Paramount, and the Los Angeles County Flood Control District. This report is being submitted for the LLAR Watershed Group by Kinnetic Laboratories, Inc. who has been contracted by the Watershed Group to carry out the monitoring program.

Between the reporting period of July 1 through December 31, 2017 the following events were conducted:

- On July 13, August 16, September 8, October 16, November 20, and December 18, 2017, KLI performed the monthly LLAR Bacteria TMDL sampling at LARB1, LARB2, and LARB7. Dry conditions were encountered at LARB7 during all months except August.
- On September 8, and November 20, 2017, KLI performed quarterly LLAR Bacteria TMDL sampling at LARE1, LARE2, and LARE3.
- On July 17 and October 23, 2017, KLI performed Metals TMDL sampling at LAR-9, LAR-10, and LAR-13. Conditions were dry at LAR-10 during the October 23 sampling.
- LA County performed dry weather sampling at S10 on July 19, 2017.
- No wet weather sampling events were conducted at any of the six stations during this period.

This information is submitted pursuant to Part XIV.L of the Monitoring and Reporting Program of the Los Angeles County Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) Permit (NPDES Permit No. CAS004001; Order No. R4-2012-0175).

The second associated Data Deliverable file is a ZIP file with all the Semi-Annual data included as EXCEL files for the period of July 1 to December 31, 2017 for the Lower Los Angeles River Watershed CIMP program.
