SUBJECT: NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON THE PROPOSED MODIFICATION TO THE UPPER SAN GABRIEL RIVER'S COORDINATED INTEGRATED MONITORING PROGRAM PURSUANT TO THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY MUNICIPAL SEPARATE STORM SEWER SYSTEM (MS4) PERMIT (NPDES PERMIT NO. CAS004001; ORDER NO. R4-2012-0175 AS AMENDED BY STATE WATER BOARD ORDER WQ 2015-0075 AND R4-2012-0175-A01)

On November 13, 2015, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Los Angeles Water Board or Board) approved the Upper San Gabriel River Watershed Management Group (Group) Coordinated Integrated Monitoring Program (CIMP).

On December 2, 2016, the Board approved a modification of the Group's CIMP.

On December 31, 2018, the Group submitted a request to make the following modifications to the CIMP:

- Based on no flow observed since October of 2015, eliminate the requirement to install an autosampler at the Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) receiving water site USGR_R4_RAM located in San Gabriel River Reach 4.
- In lieu of the requirement to install an autosampler, designate the current procedure of visual observations and grab sampling as the permanent procedure at site USGR_R4_RAM.
