NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON REQUEST FOR MODIFICATION TO THE BALLONA CREEK ENHANCED WATERSHED MANAGEMENT PROGRAM (NPDES PERMIT NO. CAS004001: ORDER NO. R4-2012-0175 AS AMENDED BY STATE WATER BOARD ORDER WQ 2015-0075 AND LOS ANGELES WATER BOARD ORDER NO. R4-2012-0175-A01)

The Ballona Creek Watershed Management Group¹ (Group) implements the Ballona Creek Enhanced Watershed Management Program (BC EWMP) under Part VI.C of the Los Angeles County MS4 Permit (Order No. R4-2012-0175).

On December 14, 2018, the Ballona Creek Watershed Management Group, as part of its 2017-2018 Annual Report and Adaptive Management Process, submitted a letter to the Los Angeles Water Board requesting a time extension for its July 2019 interim milestone in the Ballona Creek Enhanced Watershed Management Program (BC EWMP).
