Pursuant to Part 7.C.2 of the Ventura County Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) Permit, the Regional Board is announcing a 30-day public comment period prior to the Executive Officer's final approval of the Ventura County Low Impact Development Technical Guidance Manual submitted to the Regional Board on November 5, 2010 by the Ventura Countywide Stormwater Quality Management Program. The Technical Guidance Manual was developed by the Ventura County MS4 Permittees pursuant to the requirements of Part 4, Section E. IV.4(b) of the Ventura County MS4 Permit.

The public comment period will close on December 30, 2010 at 5:00 PM. Regional Board staff will consider any comments received prior to the close of the comment period before Executive Officer approval of the Ventura County Low Impact Development Technical Guidance Manual.
