SAWMILL MONITORING

The purpose of this monitoring program is to measure the performance of the storm water runoff treatment facilities and compliance with the Basin Plan. To accomplish this, the following monitoring is required:

Grab samples shall be collected monthly on the first day of the month of discharge as a result of a runoff-producing storm. Samples shall be analyzed for turbidity, total suspended solids (TSS), settleable solids, chemical oxygen demand (COD), and volatile suspended solids (VSS) as shown in the table below:

Samples shall be collected from the following locations:

1. Station 1 – Drainage ditch 5’ above confluence with Mill Creek
2. Station 2 – Mill Creek 50’ upstream of drainage
3. Station 3 – Mill Creek 50’ downstream of drainage

In addition to the above-listed constituents, the Station 1 sample shall be analyzed for Pentachlorophenol and Tetrachlorophenol.

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SAWMILL REPORTING

Analytical results shall be reported such that they are received by the first day of the second month following sampling. If no runoff occurs during a month, the report shall so state.

By July 15 of each year, an annual storm water report shall be submitted summarizing the wet season observations and collected data. The report shall discuss compliance with permit conditions and describe any additional control measures that may be needed to bring the discharge into compliance. The monitoring program will be reviewed and revised, if appropriate, following a review of the summary report.

All monitoring reports shall be transmitted in accordance with the specifications of Resolution 71-5 adopted by the Regional Water Board on February 3, 1971.
