Humboldt County

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region (hereinafter, Regional Water Board), finds that

1. Pierson Lumber Company (hereinafter referred to as the discharger) is a hardware and lumber store owned by Pierson Investment Company and is located at 4100 Broadway in Eureka, California. The property is further described as Humboldt County Assessors Parcel No. 019-251-04, and is located within the southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33, Range 1 West, Township 5 North, Humboldt Base and Meridian.
2. On December 5, 2002, the Regional Water Board adopted Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R1-2002-0110 and Monitoring and Reporting Program No. 2002-0110 for the discharger. Order No. R1-2002-0110 was issued to regulate the discharge of an in-situ remediation project consisting of the injection of a microbial and nutrient solution called BioJet® to shallow groundwater. On September 26, 2003, Monitoring and Reporting Program Order No. R1-2002-0110 was revised and replaced by Monitoring and Reporting Program Order No. R1-2003-113. On June 29, 2004, Monitoring and Reporting Program Order No. R1-2003-113 was revised and replaced by Monitoring and Reporting Program Order No. R1-2004-0058.
3. The discharger injected BioJet® into the subsurface during two separate events. The first application of BioJet® solution was conducted in February of 2003. Approximately 6,580 gallons was injected into the subsurface during the first application. The second application occurred in June of 2004. Approximately 1,500 gallons of BioJet® solution was injected into the subsurface. No more applications of the BioJet® solution are proposed. Therefore, Order No. R1-2002-0110 and the associated Monitoring and Reporting Program Order No. R1-2004-0058 are no longer necessary.
4. The Regional Water Board action to rescind Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R1-2002-0110 and Monitoring and Reporting Program Order No. R1-2004-0058 is exempt

from provision of the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resources Code Section 21000 et seq.) in accordance with Title 14, California Code of Regulation, Section 15061(b)(3).

5. The Regional Water Board notified the public of its intent to rescind existing waste discharge requirements and has provided an opportunity for comment.
6. The Regional Water Board, in a public hearing, heard and considered all comments pertaining to this matter.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R1-2002-0110 and Monitoring and Reporting Program Order No. R1-2004-0058 for the Pierson Lumber Company located at 4100 Broadway in Eureka, California, are rescinded.
