MONITORING

The discharger shall determine and record the maximum and average waste flow in gallons per day discharged to the waste facilities.

The discharger shall visually inspect the disposal field monthly for signs of system malfunction. The date of inspection and the depth of water below ground surface in each observation well shall be recorded.

Samples shall be collected quarterly, during the months of February, May, August, and November from one of the recreational vehicle dump station disposal field observation wells. These samples shall be analyzed for zinc, phenol, and formaldehyde. "Dry" shall be written in place of a concentration if no liquid is observed during a sampling month.

The discharger shall inspect all septic tanks and record the scum and sludge depths in each tank. Inspections shall be conducted within twelve months of the last inspection, or the last time the tank was pumped, whichever occurred most recently. The tank shall be pumped if the scum layer is within three inches of the outlet, the sludge layer is within 8 inches of the outlet, or the combined depth of solids or scum is equal to or in excess of one third of the total depth of the tank.

The discharger shall report the date and disposal site whenever a septic tank is pumped.

REPORTING

Monthly monitoring reports shall be submitted to the Board by the 30th day of the following month. Reports shall be submitted on a form similar to the attached example to clearly illustrate compliance with requirements.
