

1. On October 1, 1998, Lee A. Michlin, Executive Officer of the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board issued Revised Monitoring and Reporting Program No. 87-148 (Order) for the Beaver Lumber Company facility located at 1220 Fifth Street in Arcata (Site). The Order contained requirements for monitoring and reporting data collected from the monitoring wells installed at the Site and from surface waters following storm events.
2. On May 5, 2003, Regional Water Board staff concurred with a proposal to cease monitoring of storm water for pentachlorophenols at the Site. Site operations by current tenants of the property do not use pentachlorophenol. Groundwater monitoring is conducted under the direction of Monitoring and Reporting Program No. R1-2001-0206. Based on the available information, it is appropriate to rescind Monitoring and Reporting Program No. 87-148.

THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that Monitoring and Reporting Program No. 87-148 is rescinded.
