This Monitoring and Reporting Program (MRP) is issued pursuant to California Water Code Section (CWC) 13267(b) and requires monitoring of groundwater and vadose zone, and submission of technical reports. Reports are required on a quarterly basis. The objective of monitoring conducted under this monitoring program is to provide Norman's Dry Cleaners (Discharger) and the Regional Water Board with information concerning groundwater and vapor quality related to implementation of pilot-scale testing for the site.

Under the authority of CWC section 13267(b), the Discharger is required to comply with the following monitoring and reporting requirements.

MONITORING

Monitoring parameters, test methods, sample identifications, monitoring frequencies and monitoring points are detailed on Table 6-1 (Attachment A). The table shows that monitoring is composed of laboratory analytes and field parameters. The frequency of monitoring includes baseline (once prior to system startup), daily, weekly, monthly, quarterly, semi-annually, and yearly depending on sampling location and sample matrix and the duration of the pilot study.

REPORTING

Reporting of monitoring data includes a start-up report followed by quarterly monitoring reports. The reports shall be submitted to this office in accordance with the following schedule:
