RECISSION OF MONITORING AND REPORTING PROGRAM
NO. R1-2003-0129

1. On November 6, 2003, Catherine Kuhlman, Executive Officer of the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board issued Monitoring and Reporting Program No. R1-2003-0129 (Order) for the Simpson Samoa Company facility located in Samoa (Site). The Order contained requirements for monitoring and reporting data collected from the monitoring wells installed at the Site in the area of the former aboveground storage tanks.
2. On April 17, 2008, Regional Water Board staff concurred with the recommendation that no further monitoring of groundwater was necessary in conjunction with discharges associated with the former aboveground storage tanks. Water quality objectives have been met in the monitoring wells for Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons. Based on the available information, it is appropriate to rescind Monitoring and Reporting Program No. R1-2003-0129.

THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that Monitoring and Reporting Program No. R1-2003-0129 is rescinded.
