RECISION OF CLEANUP AND ABATEMENT ORDER  
NO. R1-2008-0044

FOR

Renner Petroleum Spill  
At Mile Post 11.39  
Gasquet, California

Del Norte County

1. On April 2, 2008, Robert R. Klamt, Interim Executive Officer of the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board issued revised Cleanup and Abatement Order (CAO) No. R1-2008-0044 for the Renner Petroleum Spill located at Highway 199 Mile Post 11.39 near Gasquet, California (Site). CAO No. R1-2008-0044 replaced CAO No. R1-2008-0036 which was issued by Robert R. Klamt on March 7, 2008. The order contained requirements for actions to cleanup and abate the discharge and threatened discharge of diesel fuel to waters of the State.
2. On July 23, 2008 Regional Water Board staff concurred with the Remedial Action Plan (RAP) for the Site. The RAP was implemented which involved removal and off-site disposal of more than 1000 yards of fine-grained soils, on-site washing treatment of coarse-grained soils, and extraction and treatment of more than 600,000 gallons of groundwater. No diesel fuel has been identified during post-cleanup verification monitoring. No comments were received from the public during the No Further Action public noticing to close the case. Based on this information, it is appropriate to rescind CAO No. R1-2008-0044.

THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that CAO No. R1-2008-0044 is rescinded.
