1. On March 30, 1988, Benjamin D. Kor, Former Executive Officer of the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board issued Monitoring & Reporting Program Order No. 88-51 for Pellini Chevrolet (Site) located at 105 Petaluma Road, in Sebastopol.
2. On May 3, 1990, Benjamin D. Kor issued Cleanup & Abatement Order No. 90-100 for the Site.
3. The Sonoma County Local Oversight Program has been the lead agency overseeing the investigation and cleanup
4. On April 29, 2009, Catherine Kuhlman, Executive Officer of the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board concurred with the Sonoma County Local Oversight Program recommendation that no further action is required for the cleanup of petroleum at the Site. The Sonoma County Local Oversight Program issued a letter to the responsible parties on July 9, 2009, stating that no further action was required for cleanup at the site. Based on the fact that the Sonoma County Local Oversight Program has closed the site, it is appropriate for the Regional Water Board to rescind Monitoring & Reporting Program Order No. 88-51 and Cleanup & Abatement Order No. 90-100.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Cleanup and Abatement Order No. 90-100 and Monitoring and Reporting Program Order No. 88-51 for Pellini Chevrolet are rescinded.
